

Dear Customer!

We have an agreement with Erste Bank that in all of their branches (in Hungary) you can pay your bills without any additional fee. Just simply go to the branch with your passport and make a deposit to our account (Do not mix up the „deposit” with the deposit you gave us in the beggining! :))

Erste bank has around 200 branches and usually they are open until 16.00, on Monday until 18.00. And there are some branches (mainly in the big malls) where you can pay until 18.00 o'clock and even on Saturday. We are sure that every customer will find a branch close to him/her home. But please check the opening hours before going there!

The way of paying:

Go to the branch (take the passport with you!), go to the cashier and tell her/him that you want to make a deposit to:

Very important!

You have to add a **note** („megjegyzés”) to the deposit. We can identify your payment from this note, so please write there **your name** and **your mobile number** and some short details of the payment (for example: august bil, dialer, reconnection fee, etc.).

If you want you can print this page out, so it will be with you anytime you got to the bank.

In case **you want to make a transfer** from **your hungarian bank account** to ours, you have to use the same account number. You cannot make a transfer from a not hungarian bank account!

Here is little help if you encounter a bank clerk without any knowledge of English:
